Elections Code 9295. Public examination of arguments, ordinance and analysis.

(b) (1) During the 10-calendar-day public examination period provided by this section, any voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held, or the elections official, himself or herself, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.

Argument Against Ballot Proposition

Vote NO on the 3,600 home Harmony Specific Plan/Development Agreement. Vote NO to 34,000 more daily car trips on our streets! Vote NO to losing open space! Vote No to threatening our water reserves!

Thousands of Highland residents petitioned to put Harmony on the ballot. Now, the future of Highland is in your hands. False promises by a powerful developer are justifying a 3,600 unit residential project. Close to 2,000 additional homes have been approved or being considered compounding Harmony's impact. As Highland residents we ask you consider:

Traffic: 34,000 more daily car trips would be generated by the Harmony project. A developer-paid study shows freeway impacts will be significant and unavoidable. Ten major intersections would see "significant and avoidable" impacts. Air quality will suffer!

Water: Future droughts will happen. The millions of gallons needed daily for Harmony could facilitate permanent reliance on imported water. Harmony would add pressure for future water rate increases. By 2035 20% of the East Valley Water District's demand would be just for Harmony residents.

Public Safety: In 2016, Highland had a 0.6 ratio of sworn officers to 1,000 residents. The nationwide rate was 2.4 sworn officers per 1,000 residents. More police services will be needed for Harmony! A promised fire station will only be built after the first 1,000 homes. A disaster waiting to happen.

Crowded schools: Harmony will generate the need for a new K-5 school and portions of a middle and high school. The developer is paying the minimum school impact fees. Taxpayers would be forced to help pay for new schools for Harmony's students.

Loss of Open Space: Over 1,000 acres of open space will be lost forever. Wildlife corridors would be compromised.

Harmony is the wrong project in the wrong place. Protect our future. Vote NO.


