The City of Highland has been awarded \$264,500 in grant funding from the South Coast Air Quality Management District, Mobile Source Reduction Review Committee, for construction of sidewalks and sidewalk access improvements, bus stop access improvements, landscaping improvements, LED street lighting, “street to trail” connections, bicycle detection systems, and bicycle way-finding signs on Boulder Avenue from the San Manuel Village Entrance to Greenspot Road. The project is intended to encourage non-motorized transportation.
