



Important Public Notice

All Fireworks Prohibited

The Highland Police & Fire Departments wish to remind everyone that fireworks (safe and sane included) are not permitted in the City of Highland. It is a violation to possess, use or sell any type of fireworks within city limits. Violation of the city ordinance could result in a \$1,000 fine and/or arrest.

The Highland Police & Fire Departments will have extra personnel working over the July 4th holiday period for specific fireworks enforcement. Any fireworks discovered will be confiscated and the violations addressed. Possession of explosive devices exceeding 50 milligrams is considered a felony.

Individuals may also be held civilly liable for damages resulting from use of fireworks and for costs of a response by the Fire or Police Departments. Parents will be held liable for damages caused by their children.

There are many public firework displays planned throughout the area. Immanuel Baptist Church will host a free public firework show on July 4th. The City of Highland urges residents to attend these celebrations.
